NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District (the "Board") will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held *Tuesday, April 2, 2024, at 12:00 Noon.*

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the Board meeting held on March 5, 2024;
3. Security Report;
4. Presentation by Best Trash, LLC, the District's solid waste collection and recycling services provider, regarding annual consumer price index rate increase and adoption of amended Rate Order in connection with same;
5. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports; authorize the payment of invoices presented;
6. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent taxes; authorize the payment of invoices presented, approval of tax refunds, and transfer of accounts to the uncollectible roll;
7. Review of Delinquent Tax Collection Attorneys' Report from Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, L.L.P.; authorize any action necessary and appropriate in connection therewith, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
8. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Real Property Taxes and authorize the delinquent tax attorney to pursue the collection of delinquent real property taxes beginning July 1, 2024, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
9. Discussion regarding existing and potential tax-exempt multi-family developments within the District and authorize any actions necessary in connection therewith;
10. Operation and Maintenance Report, including:
 - A. Monthly report;
 - B. Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities, and the taking of any action in connection therewith and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, including:
 - i. Status of replacement of Wastewater Treatment Plant ("WWTP"), Lift Pump No. 2; and
 - ii. Status of repair/replacement of WWTP, blower motor no. 3; authorize filing of an insurance claim relative to same;

 - D. Refer accounts for collection;
 - E. Approve write-offs of uncollectible accounts;
 - F. Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same;
 - G. Status of painting of District fire hydrants;
 - H. Review manhole survey; and
 - I. Status of pumping and hauling of sanitary sewage from lift station no. 2 being constructed by HEB;
11. Authorize operator to prepare draft Consumer Confidence Report for review by Board of Directors;
 12. Operator's annual report regarding status of the District's Identity Theft Prevention Program (the "Program"), including discussion of Program compliance, staff training, effectiveness and suggested changes;
 13. Status of review of Drought Contingency Plan and adoption of amendments as appropriate, including the adoption of a Resolution regarding review of said plan, consider comments and input from the public, authorize publication of notice, as required;
 14. Engineer's Report, including:
 - A. Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for construction of facilities within the District, approving of related storm water plans, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - (i) Review and approval of any Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans or Storm Water Quality Management Plans related to construction within or on behalf of the District, and the execution of any documentation in connection therewith, including WWTP site permit;
 - B. Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, and approval of any related storm water permits and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - C. Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - D. Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and the acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, including:
 - (i) Easements to be dedicated from Fidelis to the District relative to the multifamily project; and
 - E. West Harris County Regional Water Authority surface water conversion matters; and
 - F. Status of Advanced Groundwater Solutions, LLC's Water Optimization Report;
 15. Issuance of utility commitments, including:
 - A. Review WBC's feasibility study on the downstream elements affected by increasing the lift station capacity in connection with WBC's request to increase its capacity from 481 ESFCs to 525 ESFCs; and
 - B. Status of capacity request for a 382 unit multifamily project;

16. Status of Bond Application Report submitted to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for proposed Series 2024 Recreational Facilities Bonds and Series 2024 Water, Sanitary Sewer and Drainage Bonds;
17. Discussion regarding the Administration Building Project and the North Park Project in the District, including:
 - A. Status of construction plans;
 - B. Status of encroachment on the Williams Pipeline easements and pipelines;
 - C. Status of providing power to the Administration Building; and
 - D. Status of deed from Windstone Colony Homeowner's Association to the District to convey the tract(s) from the Administration Building Project to the District;

20. Convene Closed Session for consultation with attorney regarding pending or threatened litigation or matters protected by attorney-client privilege pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, as amended;

23. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
